- Processional "Down the Aisle"

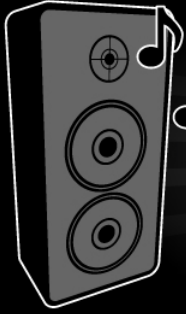
At the Church

- Shots of chauffeur
- Signing in registry shots

- Signing of Wedding Certificate (full and ring(s) close-ups)
- Recessional "Up the Aisle"

- Grand entry into hall (pairs announced) and Flower Girl and Ring Bearer
- Dinner in progress
- The "Kissing Thing" (Making the Bride and Groom kiss)
- The MC / The Speeches
- Toasts offered
- Cake cutting (full view)
- Hand shot of cutting the cake / ring shots
- The Garter and Bouquet toss activities
- Don't forget: The First Dance, Bride and Father, Groom and Mother, Wedding Party, Initial opening dance for guests, the Band and/or DJ, Dedications during reception dance, The farewell dance as well as the Bride and Groom leaving the reception
